



2016 TRASH PICKUP INFORMATION
FOR ALL QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS

Trash is collected curbside in plastic garbage bags or garbage cans weighing no more than 50lbs. when full. Trash and recycling must be curbside by **7:00 a.m.** *Trash can only be set to the curb for a maximum of 48 hours, no more than 10 bags per week. If you have large items, i.e. couch, refrigerator, oven, mattress, furniture, etc. you MUST call Emterra to have it hauled away or township residents paying for service can get a FREE dump permit once a month, available in the Supervisor's Office, Davison Township Municipality on Irish Road.* No loose debris, appliances containing Freon, tires, car parts, car batteries, renovation waste, concrete, soil, rocks or bricks, fencing, household hazardous waste, construction or landscaping excavated waste, roofing repairs, or replacements, shingles or siding, animal feces or dead animals, or industrial manufacture waste pickup.

If a holiday falls on or before your scheduled day, pickup will be one (1) day later.

OBSERVED HOLIDAYS ARE:

*New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day,
Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.*

ONLY THESE HOLIDAYS ARE OBSERVED AND WILL EFFECT TRASH PICK UP

To dispose of medical waste, unacceptable materials, household hazardous waste and individual household items weighing more than 50 lbs. please call Emterra's customer service at 1-877-609-6753 for instructions. There are separate trucks for trash, recycling and yard waste so please be patient for your pickups. Latex paint can be dried up with kitty litter or sand and set curbside with the lid off.

YARD WASTE INFORMATION

Yard waste collection is provided the first Tuesday of April through the last Tuesday in November. No tree stumps or trunks are accepted. Yard waste is picked up every week during seasonal pickup. It can be set curbside in the brown paper kraft bags or a container clearly marked YARD WASTE. Stickers are available in the Supervisor's Office for free.

CAN BE RECYCLED: newspaper (including glossy inserts), brown paper bags, magazines, catalogs, junk mail (remove personal information), telephone books, papers, paperboard (basically all boxed items and towel/toilet paper tubes) cardboard (needs to be cut to 24" x 24" pieces), narrow neck bottles, plastic grocery bags, glass bottles and jars, any color, including wine and alcohol (please rinse), metal cans, Styrofoam (up to a #6). RECYCLING stickers are available in the Supervisor's office.

CANNOT BE RECYCLED: PIZZA BOXES, Styrofoam (over #7), electronics, ceramics or dishes, food waste, cooking oil containers, motor oil containers, hazardous waste containers, light bulbs, window glass, mirrors and yard waste.

Bins are available at Rewards for Recycling located at 1133 S. State Road (next to Jimmy John's), 810-653-2325 OR you can purchase your own larger bin (make sure to clearly mark Yard Waste, stickers available in Supervisor's office). Items do not have to be separated and can go in one bin (please try to rinse and clean off debris). Rewards for Recycling is a program that keeps track of each time you recycling and enters you in a contest. Don't miss out get signed up today.
