



PADDLE BOARD RENTAL

\$10 per hour

\$5 per additional hour

RULES

- AGE:
 - Must be 18 years of age or older to rent paddle boards.
 - You must be 10 years of age or older to be on a paddle board alone.
 - Only one person on a paddle board at a time. Children 9 years of age and under may ride with an adult 18 years of age or older.
- A waiver must be filled out for each person using a paddle board. Legal guardian must sign for anyone under 18 years of age. (Forms can be found on our website).
- A Driver's license is required to hold while paddle boards are rented out.
- A Life jacket must be worn at all times. US Coast Guard Certified. (If you are caught without the life jacket on you will be asked to leave the park without a refund from the paddle board rental and without a park entrance refund. You can also lose your privileges to rent paddle boards in the future.)
- Paddle boards must be returned to the boat house at the time indicated to you when you check out the board. If you return a paddle board late you will be charged \$5 for every 10 minutes you are late.
- Paddle boards are rented out at the Beach Treats Concession stand, located in the Grand Pavilion. Once rented paddle boards should be picked up and returned to the boat house.
- Paddle boards are not allowed in the roped off swimming area.
- Paddle boards are not allowed west of the observation deck.
- No horseplay on paddle boards.
- If you damage or lose a paddle or board you will be responsible to pay \$100 per paddle and/or \$600 per board.
