Storm Water Ordinance

**ORDINANCE NO: 2010-6**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF  
STORM WATER UPON PAVED STREETS AND  
PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF**

**The Township Board of the Township of Davison ordains:**

**SECTION 1**

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to alter ground elevation, construct, arrange or continue to maintain any conduit, pipe or drain which collects runoff water or storm water from his property or from his roof or from around the foundation of any structure on his property, concentrate the flow thereof and discharges such collected water onto the pavement of any paved curb and gutter. Further, if a storm water sewer or drain is located within 300 hundred feet of the property line, the property owner must connect to the existing storm sewer or drain at their expense.

**SECTION 2**

This ordinance is not intended to prohibit the discharge of unpolluted storm water into open roadside ditches.

**SECTION 3**

The penalty for violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor subject to a fine of up to Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and/or up to ninety (90) days in jail at the discretion of the Court.

**SECTION 4**

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication.
