**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2010-51, SECTION 2 AN ORDINANCE
FOR THE ABATEMENT OF THE OVERGROWTH OF WEEDS AND OR GRASSES**

THE TOWNSHIP OF DAVISON ORDAINS:

AMENDMENT

Section 2-- Cutting of grass and weeds shall be deleted and replaced by the following:

It shall be the duty of the occupant or owner of every premises or vacant land and the owner of unoccupied premises within the Township, to cut and remove or destroy by lawful means all such weeds, grass, or rank noxious or harmful vegetation as often as may be necessary to comply with the provisions of this ordinance. In platted subdivisions, condominium or site condominium projects that have vacant lots not adjacent to a dwelling (whether occupied or not) only the right-of-way shall be required to be mowed.

SECTION I – Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this ordinance full force and effect.

SECTION II – Severability

Should any section, subdivision, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so invalidated.

SECTION III – Savings

All proceedings pending and all rights and liabilities existing, acquired or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they are commenced.

SECTION IV -- Effective date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication thereof.
